Andrew and Sarah Bailey — Phoenix, Arizona

Phoenix is located in the desert and is one of the biggest city in Arizona, with more than 1.6 million people and becoming one of the fastest-growing cities in our nation. Thousands of people move there every year when they retire because of the weather. Our missionaries, live here with their two children. Andrew is the church-planting pastor of a new church called Cross Church which reach out to local residents who struggle with addiction to drugs, alcohol or other dark forces. They see firsthand how the Gospel can radically transform people with such problems. One man that has come to faith in Christ and recovered from his addiction to drugs and alcohol wants to minister to others with similar problems. Our church has a part in helping this man change his life because our Cooperative Program giving supports the Baileys in their ministry. Let's pray that, through our missionaries and this new church, many across Phoenix will come to know Jesus as Savior and Lord!
